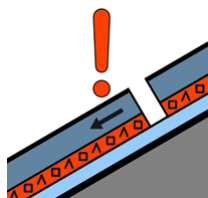


## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

Persistent Weak Layers



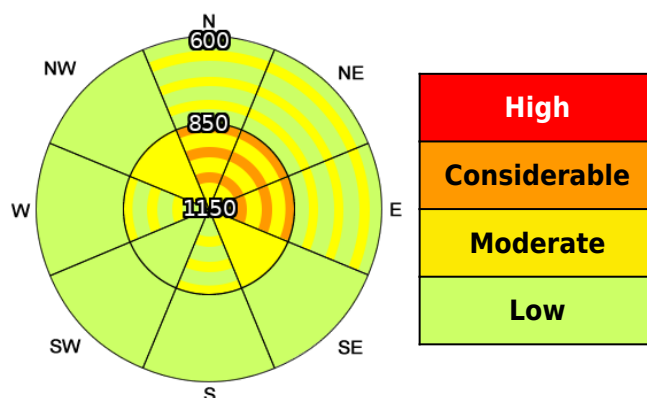

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

With the onset of rapid thaw conditions stability will become increasingly poor. Greatest hazard will be found in deep accumulations on steep terrain mainly on North to East aspects above 850 metres where avalanches are likely. Gully exits and scarp slopes will be particularly affected. Cornices above these aspects will be prone to collapse. Elsewhere, localised instabilities will also be present on other aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will rise above the summits and there will be rain at all levels. Winds will be very strong, initially from the South but veering to the South-West.

#### Comments

Likely to be a poor day on the summits Tuesday.
