
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will re freeze and stability will be good throughout. Some new deposits of unstable windslab will form in steep wind sheltered places above 900 metres on mostly North-West to North-Easterly aspects, but these deposits are not expected to be extensive. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Colder conditions are expected with a freezing level around 800 metres, but above the summits for a short time overnight. Some snowfall is expected, mostly light snow showers above 600 metres throughout the forecast period. Winds will be moderate to strong South to South -Westerly
