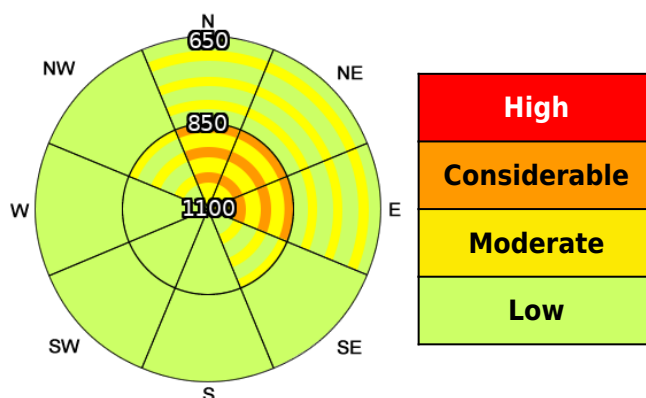

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Good stability on all recently scoured locations. Weakly bonded accumulations of windslab will be present on steep North to East aspects above 850m where instability will tend be localised and confined to the top of cols, steep scarp slopes and gully exits. New, small and weak cornices will overhang many of these places. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers continuing overnight and into the morning. Strong South West winds easing to moderate before dawn, later light and variable. Becoming progressively colder with freezing level down to 600m during the day.
