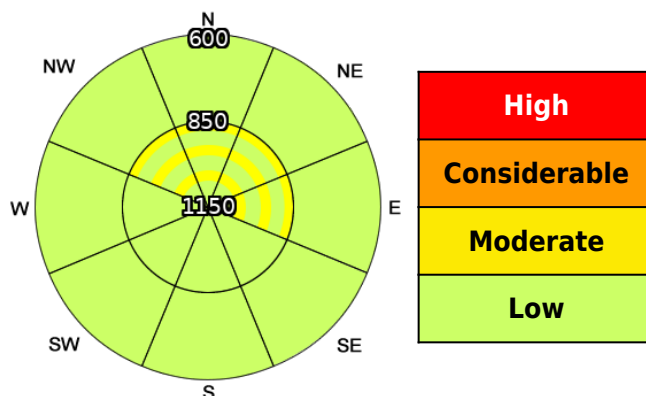

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The majority of the snowpack will be well bonded and stable. Localised instabilities will develop in steep sheltered terrain such as gully exits and corrie rims mainly on North-West through North to East aspects above 850 metres. Any remaining cornices will remain unstable. Areas exposed to recent strong winds will be scoured. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong winds from the West-South-West and West. Light snow at higher levels overnight, followed by a rise in the freezing level and light rain at all levels.

Comments

Becoming milder again, freezing levels well above the summits.
