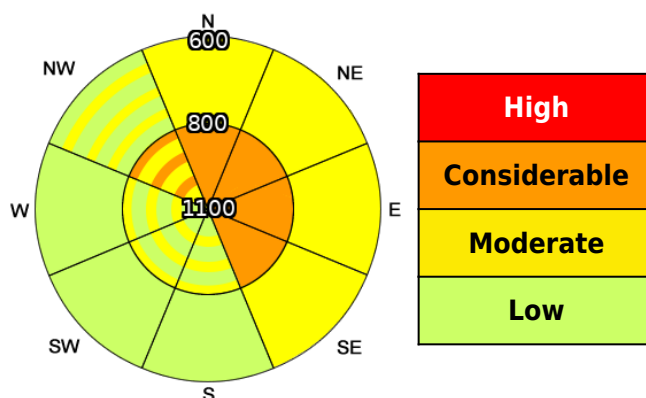

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will continue to be deposited in sheltered areas throughout the period. Greatest accumulations will be on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Other aspects, especially North-West, will also be affected. Cornices will be fragile and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snowfall is expected throughout the forecast period, increasing in intensity during the morning. The freezing level will be around 600-700 metres. Winds will be strong throughout, initially Westerly then backing South-Westerly overnight.
