

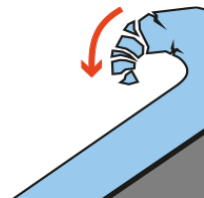

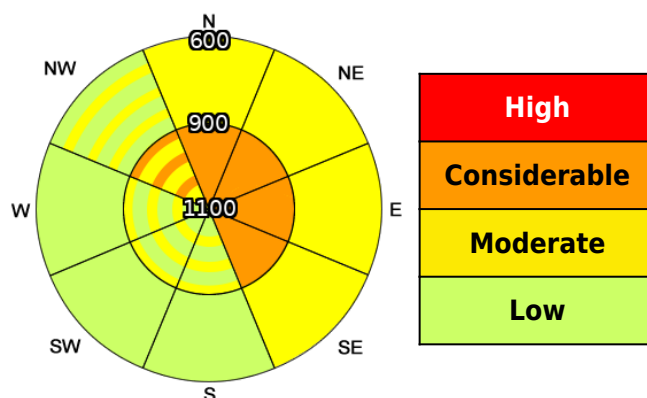
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New accumulation of windslab will develop and are expected to achieve depth in sheltered areas throughout the period. Greatest accumulations will be on North through East to South-East aspects above 900 metres where avalanches are likely. Other aspects, especially North-West, will also be affected. Cornices will be fragile and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Further heavy precipitation is expected overnight and during the day bringing snow above 500 metres. The freezing level initially around 700-800 metres overnight, will lower to around 500 metres during the day. Winds will be strong throughout, initially West-South-West, then West.
