

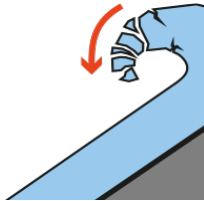

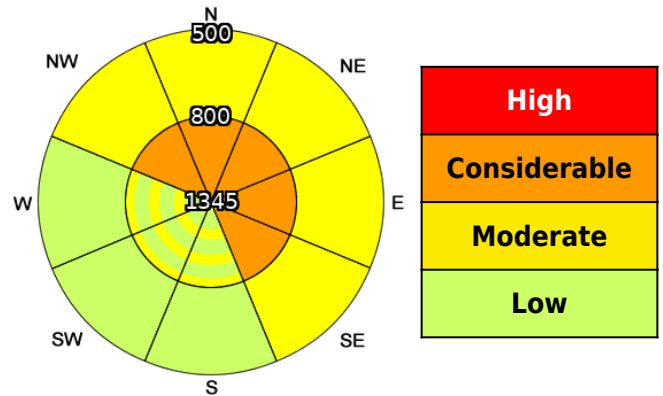
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will continue to be deposited in sheltered areas throughout the forecast period. Greatest accumulations will be on North-West through North and East to South-East aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Cornices will be fragile and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

A period of heavy snowfall is expected this evening with very strong South-South-West winds and a freezing level around 800 metres. Thereafter, frequent snow showers above 400 metres will continue throughout the forecast period with strong West-South-West, then West, winds.

Comments

A snowy forecast period is in prospect with snow potentially to low levels.
