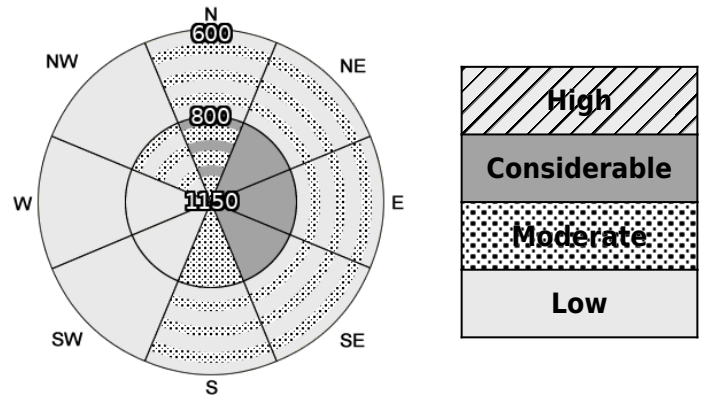

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will persist in sheltered gullies and on slopes with a North through East to South-East aspect mainly above 800 metres. Gully exits and corniced areas where deeper accumulations exist will be particularly affected. Exposed slopes will remain firm and icy. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers overnight with strong West-North-West winds. It will become dry by morning and winds will become fresh to moderate South-Westerly. The freezing level will be around 500 metres through the period.

Comments

Becoming more settled and calmer on Friday. Cornices will remain fragile. Windward icy slopes require great care due to the serious and dire runout potential.
