

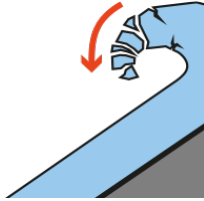

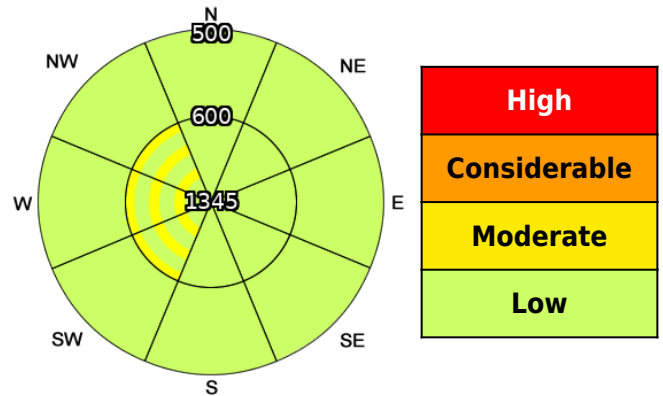
Persistent Weak Layers

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Little change is expected in the snowpack. A complex pattern of windslab varying in consistency and stability will exist. Most affected will be North-East through East to South aspects above 900 metres. However, some more isolated pockets will be found on other aspects and at lower levels. Some substantial cornices will remain. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Northerly winds will ease to become light and variable during the day. After a few light snow showers early in the night it will be generally dry. The freezing level will be around 600 metres.

**Comments**

Lighter winds than of late expected over the next few days.
