

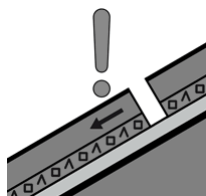

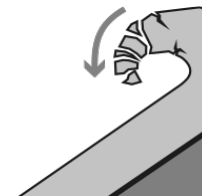
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



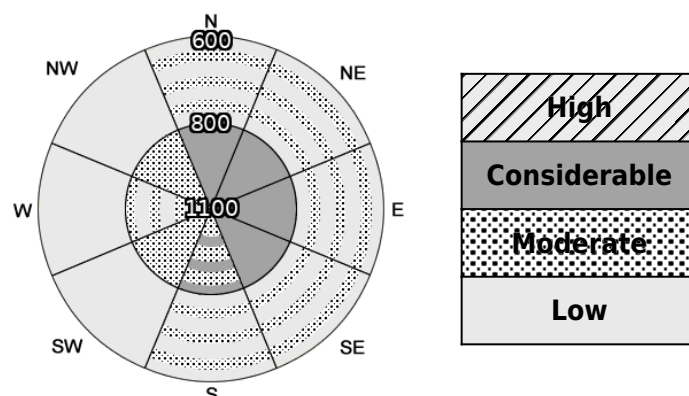
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will continue to be deposited in sheltered areas overnight, mainly on East through South to South-West aspects above 800 metres. Recent variable accumulations of unstable windslab will also be present, mainly on North through East to South-East aspects. Cornices will be fragile and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers are expected overnight, then a dry day. The freezing level will be around 500 metres. Winds will be strong Northerly overnight; easing to moderate and backing through North-West to South-West during the day.

Comments

Significant snow transport throughout Thursday and this will continue overnight and into the morning. Variable composition windslab is present on most aspects.
