

Wind Slab





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Moderately bonded windslab will be present, mainly in steep sheltered locations on South-East to South-West aspects above 800 metres. New light accumulations will also start to build later in the afternoon on these aspects. Isolated instabilities will also persist in steep lee locations on North-East and East aspects. Recently formed cornices will remain unstable. Elsewhere, areas exposed to recent strong winds will be scoured, icy or bare. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Initially light and variable winds but strengthening from the North in the afternoon. There will be light snowfall throughout the day above 500 metres.

Comments

Light snow during the day, with drifting increasing later in the afternoon.
