

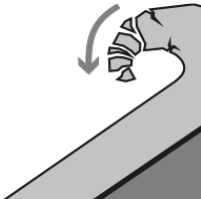

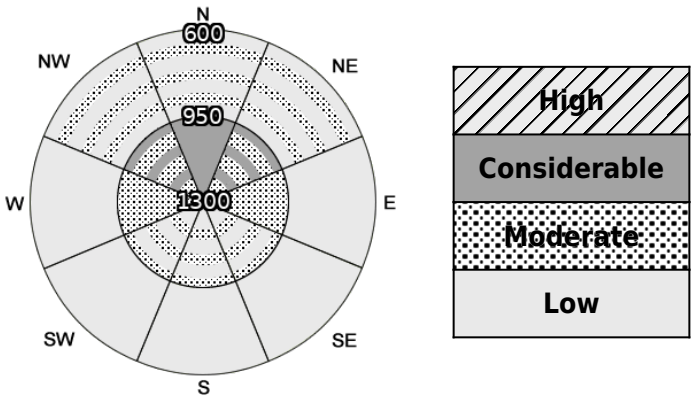

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Drifting snow with new accumulations of poor to weakly bonded windslab developing as the day progresses on North-West to North-East aspects mainly above 950 metres. Steep sheltered locations such as coire rims, gully tops and crag aprons will be especially affected. West and East aspects will be affected by cross loading. Isolated windslab will develop on these aspects below 950 metres. New cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry, light Southerly winds will strengthen through the day. The 700 metre freezing level will fall to around 500 metres.

Comments

Potential for a lot of drifting, especially as winds strengthen through the afternoon.
