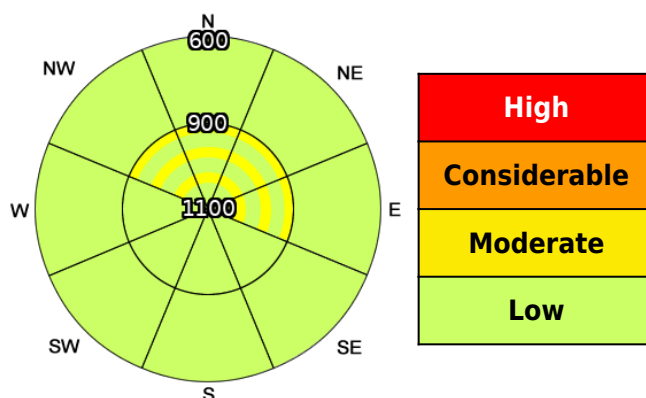
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change. The snowpack will continue to consolidate. Some re-distribution of existing deposits onto North Westerly aspects towards the end of the day is possible. Pockets of moderately well bonded windslab will persist above 950m, on steepest North through East to South-East aspects. Good stability below 850m and on wind scoured slopes and ridges. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry and settled. Light Southerly winds will increase overnight and become moderate South-Westerly by the end of the day. Overnight the Freezing level will lower slightly from 600m to around 400m.

Some good ski touring on offer; if lines chosen carefully and prepared to carry up to 400m.
