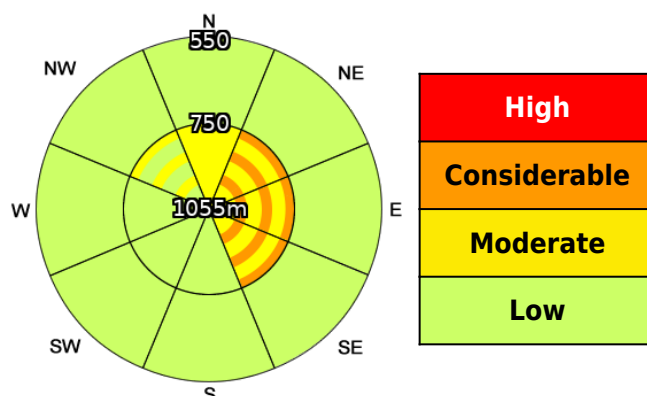

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of fresh unstable windslab will build on North-East to South-East aspects, particularly in wind sheltered locations such as gully exits and corrie rims above 750 metres. Cornices will build above these aspects where they will be fragile and prone to collapse. Localised accumulations of unstable windslab will persist on sheltered North-West to North facing aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight a cold front will bring a period of light to moderate snowfall with snow showers during the remainder of the day. South-South Westerly winds will veer becoming WNW and moderate in strength during the early part of the night and remaining from that direction during tomorrow. The freezing level falling to all levels during the night.

Comments

Significant snow transport throughout the day with more snow forecast overnight to all levels.
