#### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 08/02/2018


##### Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Redistributed deposits will form fresh windslab on North-West through North to East aspects above 800 metres. Moderately well bonded deposits will also be present on South-East, and to a lesser extent, on South aspects. Deepest accumulations will form in wind sheltered locations such as gully exits and around corrie rims. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Intermittent light snow forecast. Strong, generally South-Westerly winds overnight will ease to become moderate during the morning. They will back South-South-Westerly and then increase to strong by the middle of the afternoon. The freezing level will rise to 700 metres overnight and remain there during the day.

##### Comments

Snow shower frequency and intensity may vary from forecast. Local variations are possible.
