

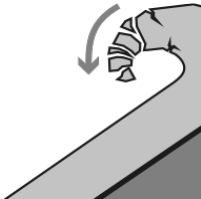

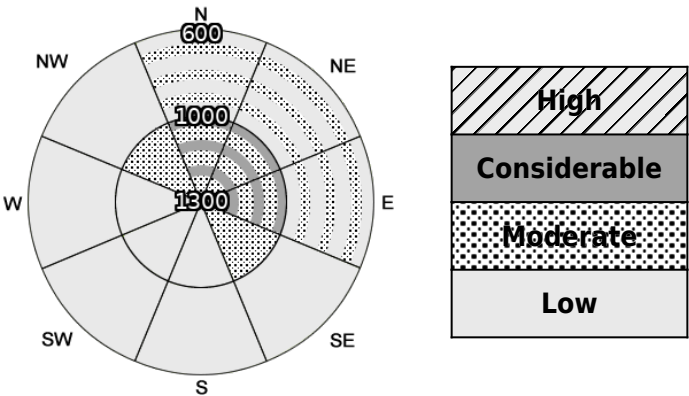
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will persist on Northerly to Easterly aspects mainly above 1000 metres. Areas of steep and convex terrain will be most affected. New windslab will also develop in these areas. More localised instabilities on steep North-West and South-East aspects. Wind exposed slopes will continue to erode. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers overnight on moderate to strong South-South-West veering West-North-West winds, these are expected to clear during the early morning. Moderate to strong Westerly winds will continue through the day. The freezing level will fall from 800 to 300 metres.
