

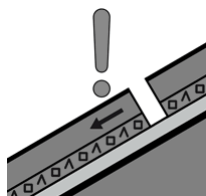

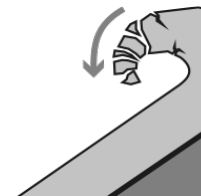
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



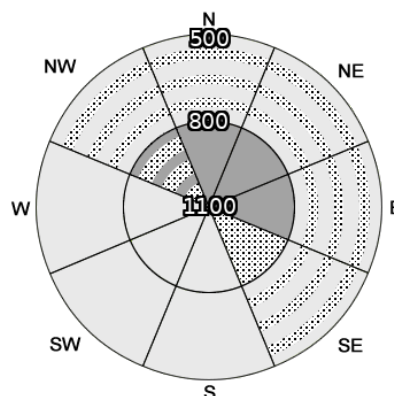
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Drifting will continue overnight and be enhanced by pre dawn snowfall. New weak windslab will be present on all steep North to East aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Cross-loading possible on selected North-West facing slopes and gullies. Recently formed cornices will be weak and prone to sudden collapse. Better stability on ridges and recently wind eroded locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry and cold overnight with Southerly winds increasing to strong. Snowfall from the early hours turning showery later in the morning. Freezing level rising to around 800 metres by mid morning.

Comments

Better snow cover above 500m on Friday.
