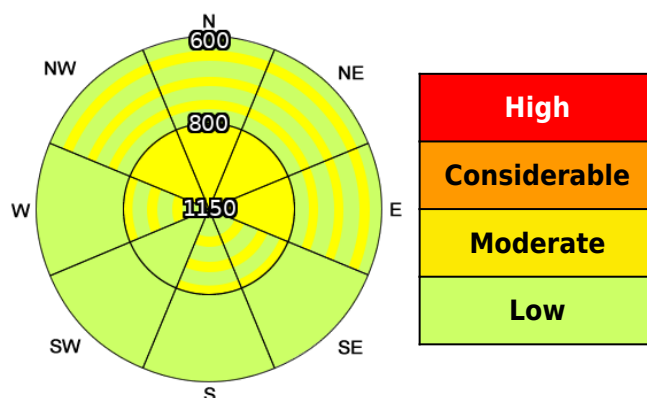


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 18/02/2018****Avalanche Problems****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Moderately well bonded deposits will be found on most aspects. Most widespread accumulations will be encountered on North-West through North to East aspects above 800 metres. At the very end of the forecast period cornice collapse at lower elevations may threaten slopes below. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will be mostly dry with the fresh overnight South-Westerly winds decreasing to moderate Southerly by the morning. By the end of the period the winds will increase to fresh South-South-Easterly. The freezing level will gradually rise from 500 metres overnight to 800 metres by 16.00 hours. A quick spike in the last hour of the forecast period will see the freezing level jump to 1000 metres.

Comments

Freezing level rising rapidly at end of forecast period: Caution required under and around cornices.
