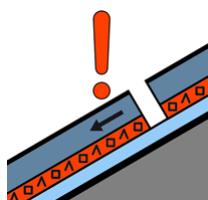
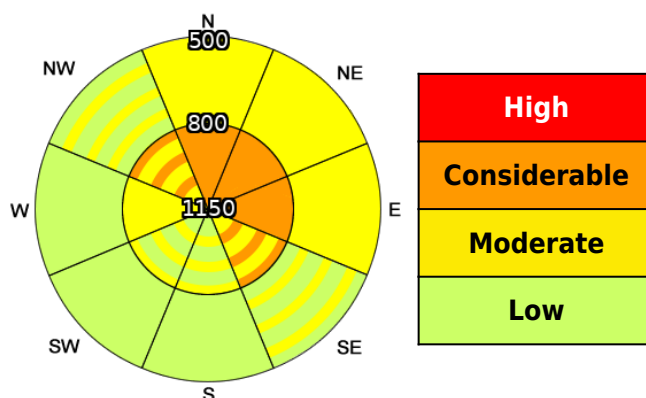


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 18/02/2018****Avalanche Problems****Persistent Weak Layers****Wet Snow****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Significant areas unstable windslab will remain on mainly North to East aspects above 800 metres. The stability of these deposits will decrease during the afternoon and evening as the freezing level rises. Avalanches are likely on steep slopes and gullies where deep deposits of windslab lie. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

**Forecast Weather Influences**

After a few overnight snow showers it will be a dry morning. Snow later in the afternoon will soon turn to rain. Through the day the freezing level will rise from around 700 metres to well above the summits.

Avalanche hazard expected to be near the top end of the Considerable category, particularly during Sunday afternoon and evening.
