



#### Avalanche Problems




Wet Snow

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will become saturated in the surface layers and surface instabilities can be expected to occur where the greatest accumulations are present, especially on steep Northerly to Easterly aspects above 900 metres. Cornices above these aspects are unstable and likely to collapse. Below this level the snowpack will be moist but stable except in steep places such as banks and gullies where it will be moderately stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Precipitation will fall as rain at all levels during the early hours and through the morning, dying out around midday. The freezing level will be well above the summits throughout the forecast period. Winds will be moderate strength Southerly veering Westerly by the end of the afternoon on the tops.
