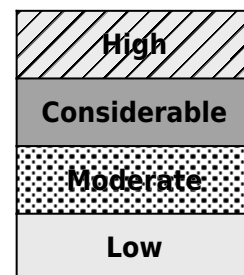
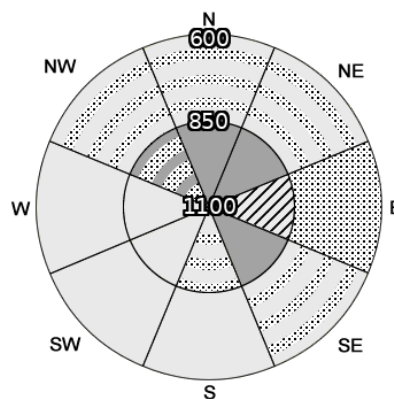
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A period of instability will ensue overnight with the onset of rain. Most affected places will be steep North-West through North to South-East and especially East aspects above 850m, where avalanches will occur. At lower elevations the snowpack although wet will be generally well consolidated and stable. NB. Some recently formed cornices above lee aspects are large with the potential to bring down wet snow events to coire floors. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be a thaw at all levels. The Freezing level will rise to well above summits overnight with rain and drizzle continuing into the morning. Winds will be generally South-Westerly and fresh throughout.
