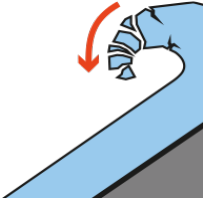

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 20/02/2018

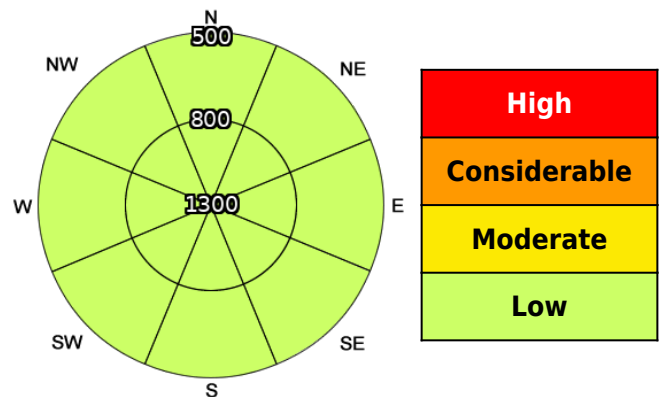
Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will refreeze in all areas and stability will be good on all aspects above 800 metres. Below this level the snowpack will remain moist but will be generally stable. Some thin snow accumulations may form on East to South-East aspects above 800 metres in wind sheltered locations but these are not expected to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, the freezing level will lower from 2000 metres to 800 metres. Some precipitation in the night, rain at first will turn to snow for a brief time above 800 metres dying out in the early hours. A dry day is expected. Winds will moderate to strong South-Westerly veering North-Westerly by day break and for the rest of the day.
