

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 21/02/2018


Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to stabilise becoming generally well bonded at all heights and on all aspects. It will refreeze above 800 metres with a crust developing. Surface sloughs remain possible on steep terrain. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry with the freezing level around 800 metres throughout the forecast period. Moderate North West winds will back South Easterly by dawn becoming light, increasing to 20 mph by the end of the day.

Comments

Continued cooling with day time freezing levels dropping to 450 metres later in the week as it becomes dry, clear and sunny! It is likely that the snow surface will become increasingly firm, especially on shaded aspects.
