

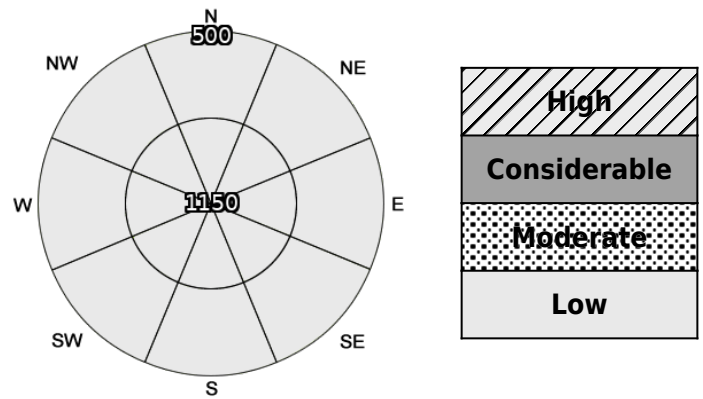

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 22/02/2018

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected in the the snowpack. Below 600 metres it will slowly thaw and consolidate. Above this level it will remain firm. Stability will remain generally good in all locations. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Although it will remain generally dry a few very light snow showers are possible during the afternoon. The freezing level will be around 600 metres. Southerly winds will gradually strengthen through the day.

Comments

Weather outlook cool and generally dry. Little significant change expected in the snowpack over the next few days.
