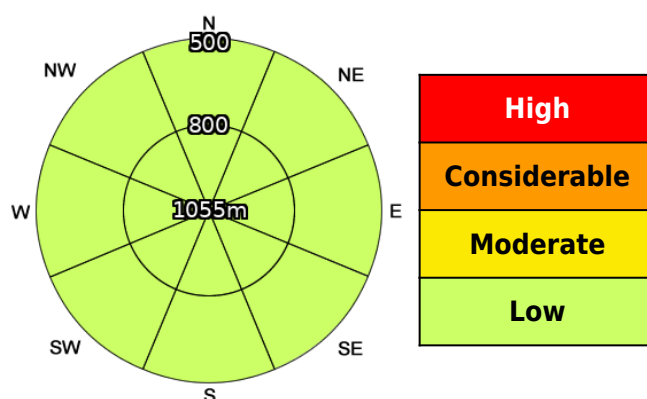


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 23/02/2018****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Little change is expected. The snowpack will be stable at all levels and aspects. The main snowline will remain patchy around 500 metres, and will be firm throughout, but particularly at higher elevations. Bare terrain and rocks exist at all levels. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

A largely dry day with a moist, cloudy and fresh Southerly airflow persisting through the period, but with brighter spells in the afternoon. The cloud base will be above summit levels and it will feel cold as the freezing level gradually lowers to around 300 metres through the day.
