
Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

For the most part the snowpack will remain well bonded and stable throughout. Some moderately bonded accumulations of drifted snow will form in steep wind sheltered locations on North-West to North-Easterly aspects mostly above 1000 metres. Gully exits, coire rims and convex shaped terrain most affected, accumulations should be localised and avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Another dry and cold, windy day is in prospect, winds will remain strong Southerly and it will be freezing at all levels. Summit temperatures between minus 5 to minus 7 degrees celsius expected throughout the forecast period.

Comments

Remaining very cold with strong South winds. Snowpack solid and icy with serious run-outs for any trips and slides, boulder fields await!
