


Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 26/02/2018

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected, the snowpack will remain frozen, stability will generally be good in most locations. Many areas will be very firm and icy. The avalanche hazard will be Low.





Forecast Weather Influences

It will continue to be cold and dry, mostly freezing at all levels. The winds will be strong through the night then easing during the day, mainly from an East-South-Easterly direction.
