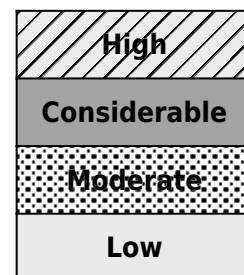
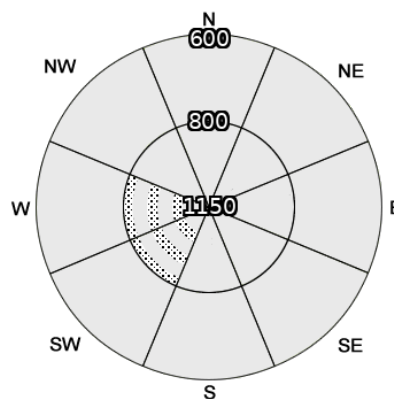


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 27/02/2018****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The majority of the snowpack will remain firm and well bonded. But, isolated new accumulations will develop mainly in wind sheltered locations on South-West and West aspects. New accumulations will be mostly on bare ground but above 950 metres new deposits will only be moderately bonded to the existing hard snow. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Remaining cold, mainly dry overnight with light snowfall throughout the day. Winds will be Northerly overnight but veering to the East-North-East for most of the day.

Comments

New snow accumulations will be greatest towards the main Cairngorms.
