

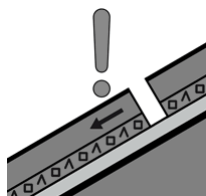

Avalanche Problems



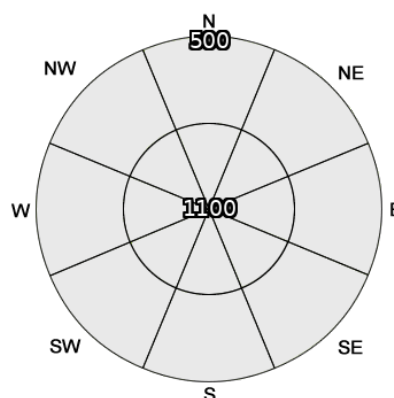
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Good stability in all locations. Small old pockets of isolated and generally avoidable thin windslab will be present on selected shaded North West through North to East aspects above 900m, with some new small accumulations also possible on South East to West aspects above 750m. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry and cold overnight with some isolated small showers to follow. A North-Easterly airflow will begin to affect the area and strengthen overnight. The Freezing level will remain below 400m.
