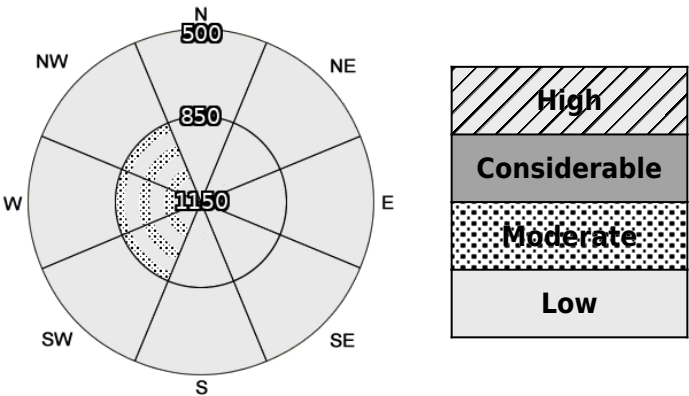
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will remain hard, icy and frozen. Fresh poorly bonded windslab deposits are expected to form on South-West to North-West aspects above 600 metres. However, these are not expected to be particularly deep or extensive, and should be generally avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain very cold with strong Easterly winds. Temperatures will remain below freezing at all levels with infrequent snow showers.
