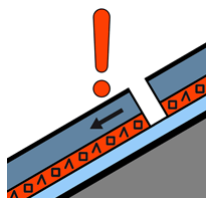
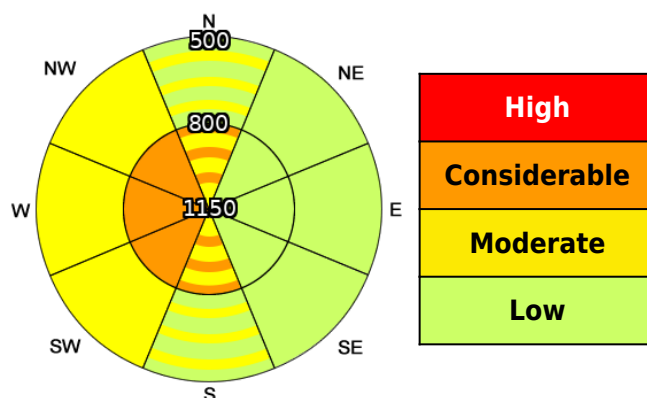

Poorly bonded windslab will continue to develop on some South and North aspects but mainly in wind sheltered locations on South-West to North-West aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Unstable cornices will continue to develop above many of these aspects. Moderately bonded accumulations will also be present in steep lee locations at lower altitudes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

Continuing cold with light snowfall and drifting in Easterly gale force winds throughout the day to low levels.
