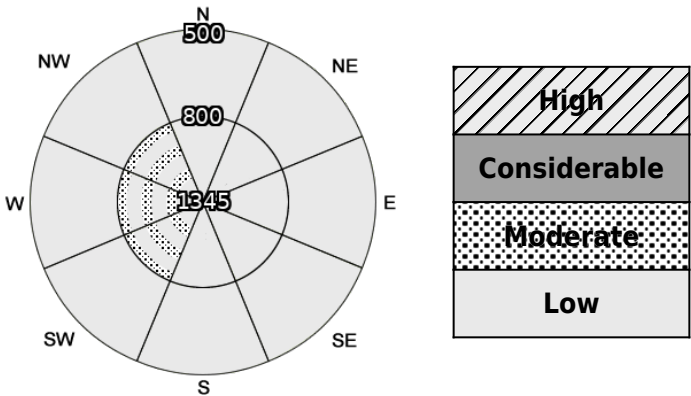
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little changes is expected in the snowpack. In general it will be hard, icy and stable. However, some areas of windslab will exist in sheltered South-West to North-West aspects above 800 metres. These areas will tend not to be extensive with the tops of slopes and gullies being most affected. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong Easterly winds will ease slightly though the period. It will remain cold and generally dry. The freezing level will be around 200 metres.

Comments

A generally hard and icy snowpack with water ice forming in water course and seepage lines. Trips or slips could have serious consequences in these conditions.
