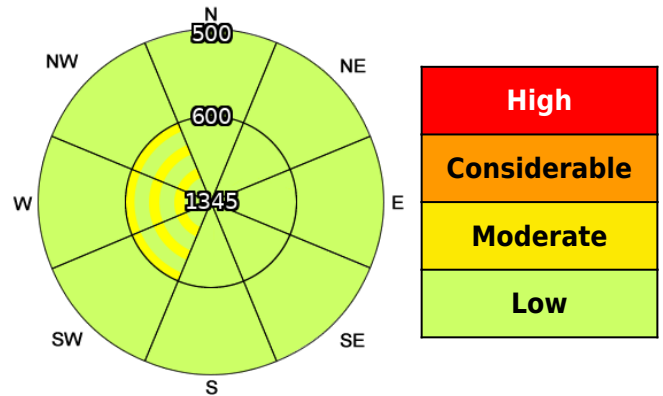
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will remain in sheltered locations on mainly South-West to North-West aspects above 600 metres. Although deep in places these will not be particularly extensive, and will be generally avoidable. The snowpack on windward aspects will be hard, icy and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Little change is expected in the weather. Moderate to strong winds will be from the East. There will be some light snow showers from time to time. The freezing level will creep up to around 500 metres.

Comments

Little windslab has formed at higher levels due to strong winds over the summits.
