

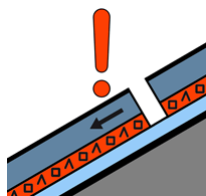

Wind Slab



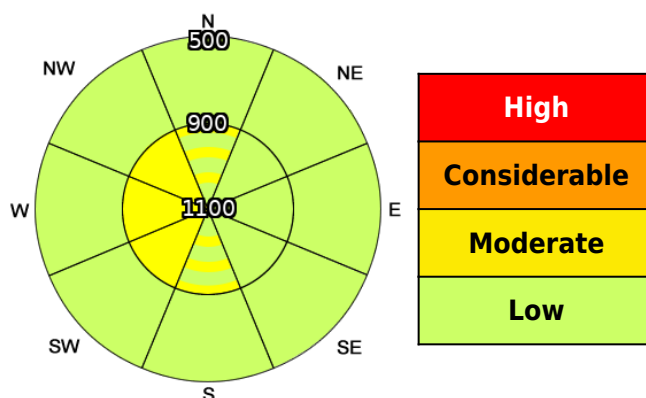
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Additional marginally stabilised windslab development expected on steep South-West to North-West aspects above 900 metres. Some consolidation expected but underlying weak layers will persist beneath some deeper windslab deposits. Minor cross loading on selected sheltered North and South aspects. Good stability in wind scoured locations. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Additional persistent light snowfall throughout the period. Moderate to strong Easterly winds. Cold but with the freezing level rising slowly to 600m by the end of the day.

Comments

Flat light. 800m cloud base all day. Poorer visibility in showers.
