

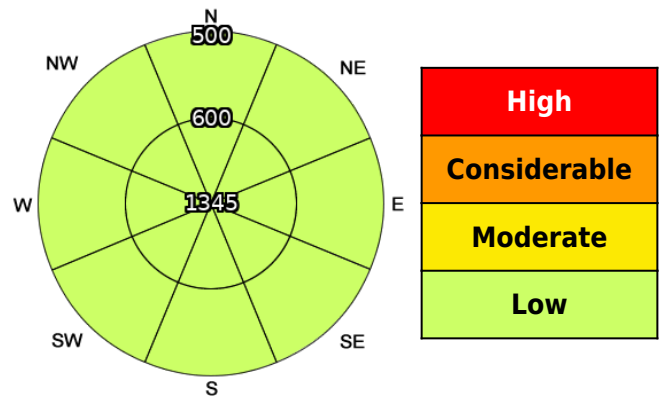

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some isolated areas of windslab will remain, mainly in sheltered hollows and gullies on South-West to North-West aspects above 600 metres. However, these will tend to be isolated and generally avoidable. Otherwise the snowpack will be refrozen, icy and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate to strong Easterly winds will continue. A few very light snow showers are possible. It will be slightly milder than of late with a freezing level of around 600 metres.

Little fresh snow in Lochaber as compared to the rest of the country.
