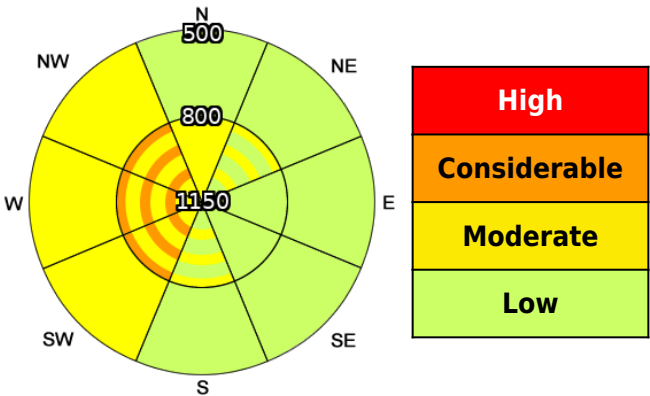
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of poor and moderately bonded windslab will persist on South-West to North-West aspects above 800 metres. With steep wind sheltered places such as ridge flanks, near summits and steep places most affected. Cross loading, and wind redistribution will also affect other aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Easterly winds will ease and veer to between the South-East and the South. There will be a few snow showers. The freezing level will be around 600 metres.

Comments

Very poor visibility on Tuesday. More of the same expected, particularly at higher levels, on Wednesday.
