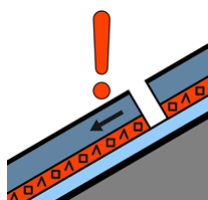
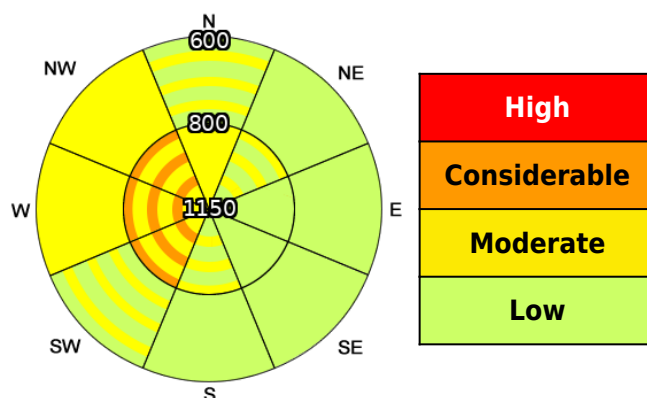


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 08/03/2018****Avalanche Problems****Persistent Weak Layers****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Localised areas of windslab will persist, mainly above 800 metres on South-West to North-West aspects with moderately bonded areas mainly on North aspects and to a lesser extent, North-East and South aspects. Below this level isolated moderately bonded windslab will also be found in steep lee locations. Easterly aspects and exposed locations will be scoured and stable. Cornices will remain a hazard. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

There will be light new snowfall, mainly overnight, then again during the afternoon. The freezing level will be around 500 metres. Winds will be fresh in strength from the South.
