

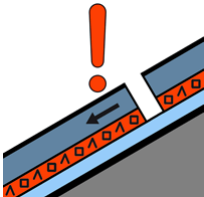

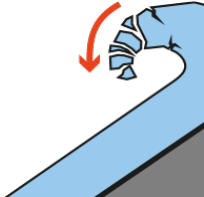
Wind Slab

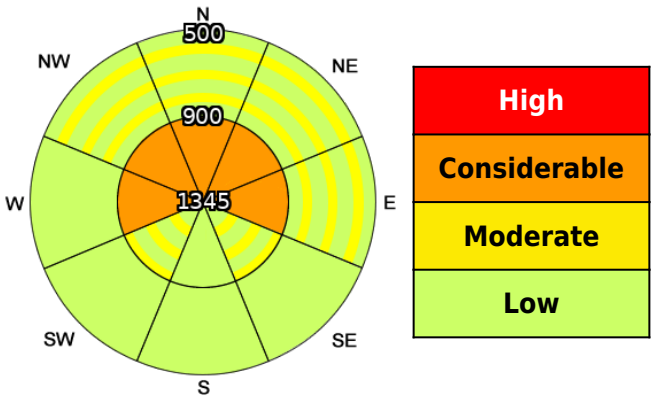

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing fresh snow will start to be redistributed onto West and North-West aspects where unstable accumulations will form mostly above 900 metres. Existing windslab instabilities will persist on North, North-East and East aspects. Wet snow instabilities will develop on steep slopes at lower elevations. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will back to the East and strengthen during the day. Showers are expected later in the period with the freezing level slowly rising to summit level later in the afternoon.
