

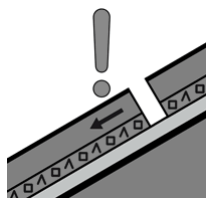

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 10/03/2018

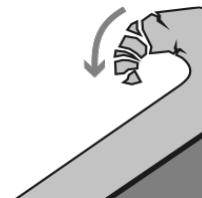
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



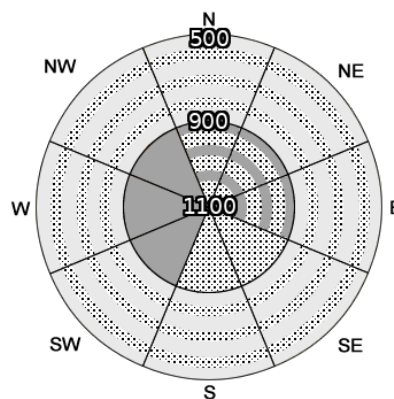
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Consolidation in all snow below 750m overnight. Drifting expected as showers commence and Easterly winds strengthen from dawn onwards. New poorly stabilised windslab expected on steep South West through West to North West aspects above 900m. Cross loading on selected sheltered North aspects. Scouring on South East and East aspects but localised instability will persist here. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry and colder overnight with light winds. Winds increasing to strong Easterly by late morning. Snowfall from dawn onwards. Freezing level rising slowly during the morning but air temperature remaining below freezing at summit level.
