




Avalanche Problems




Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack surface will become firmer in the cooler temperatures above 900 metres. The persistent weak layer will remain at depth within the snowpack on steep North-West to Northerly aspects mainly above 1000 metres. Crag aprons, coire rims and convex shaped terrain will be most affected. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry with some cloud and hill fog through the forecast period. Winds will be light and variable in direction. The freezing level will fall to 900 metres during the morning.

Comments

Weakness remaining at depth, this will become bridged by firmer surface layers.
