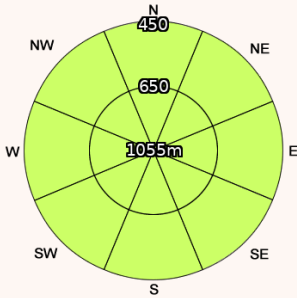


Avalanche Hazard Forecast - FOR PERIOD 18:00HRS Sun 11/03/2018 TO 18:00HRS Mon 12/03/2018



Hazard Level	Avalanche Probability
Very High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. Numerous very large, often extremely large natural avalanches can be expected.
High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. In some cases, numerous large, often very large sized natural avalanches can be expected.
Considerable	Natural and human triggered avalanches possible, in some cases large, in isolated cases very large sized natural avalanches are possible.
Moderate	Very large sized natural avalanches are unlikely. Human triggering possible in indicated steep places.
Low	Only small and medium sized natural avalanches are possible. Human triggering possible in steep, extreme terrain.

Forecast Weather Influences

Little change in conditions as winds remain light and from the East with no precipitation forecast. The freezing level remaining around or just above the summits.

Forecast Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to slowly thaw with generally good stability on all aspects. Remaining cornices and icefalls will be prone to collapse. Some sloughing can be expected on sun exposed aspects later in the day. The avalanche hazard will be Low

Observed Weather Influences

Some fresh snow overnight above 650 metres. Slow thaw as freezing level rose to above the summits during the day. Light South-Easterly winds with variable amounts of sunshine and cloud across the summits.

Observed Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack has consolidated considerably at all levels and on all aspects. It is now generally well bonded and stable through out. The patchy snow line is around 450 metres with good snow cover above 650 metres. Cornices and icefalls, especially those on South facing buttresses, collapsing in the milder temperatures. The avalanche hazard is Low.

Mountain Conditions

Observed Mountain Travel Conditions

20 percent of cloud cover at mid-day. Winds approx 10mph or less Cloudy on the tops with some bright spells.

Comments

Little change in the next 24 hours to the spring like conditions. 10 degrees down in sunny Torridon village today.
