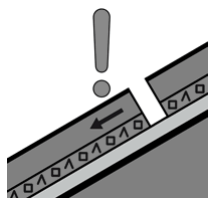


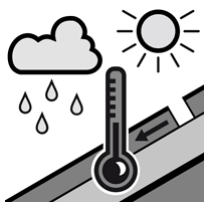

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 12/03/2018

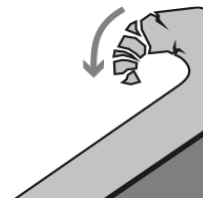

Persistent Weak Layers



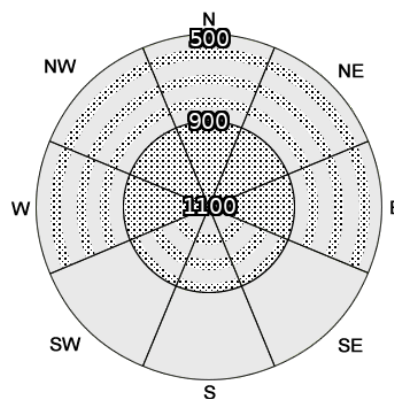

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to slowly stabilise. However, weaknesses will persist in windslab, greatest accumulations of which lie on West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to remain dry. Winds will be light Easterly overnight then more variable. The wet bulb freezing level will be around 800 metres.
