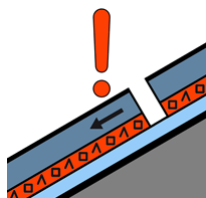

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 13/03/2018

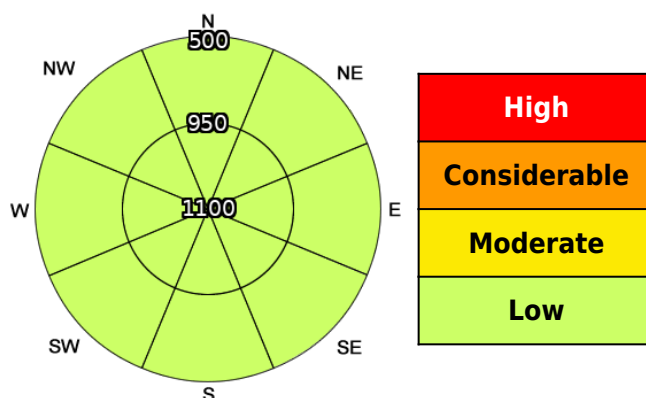
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Consolidating trend in the snowpack will continue in most locations and altitudes. Some limited, lingering and localised instability in deeper snow on North-West through North to North-East aspects above 950m. Any new wind drifted snow will be very thin and insignificant. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Generally dry though a few passing very light snow showers are possible above 800m during the early morning. Light South-West winds. Freezing at around 900m.

Comments

Consolidating trend to continue. New drifted snow expected to be insignificant in depth and extent.
