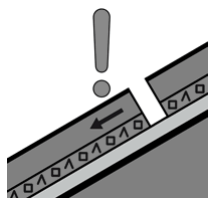


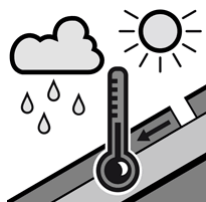

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 14/03/2018

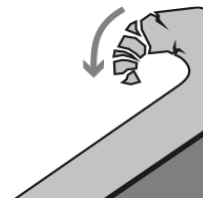

Persistent Weak Layers



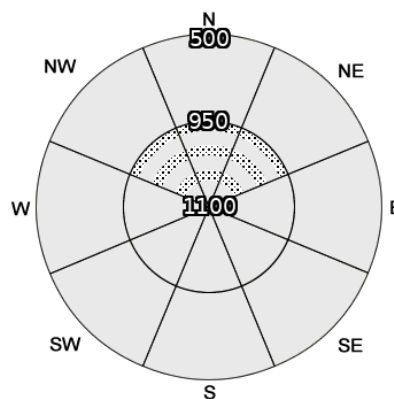

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Stability is expected to be good in most locations. Some minor and localised surface wet snow instability is possible as temperatures rise later in the day. Most affected areas will be steep North West through North to North-East aspects above 950m. All cornices expected to soften a little by day's end. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Generally dry and colder overnight but with a milder trend during the day. Some light rain or sleet is possible at the end of the period. South-East winds increasing overnight, becoming very strong by mid morning.
