

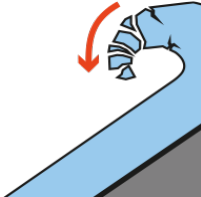

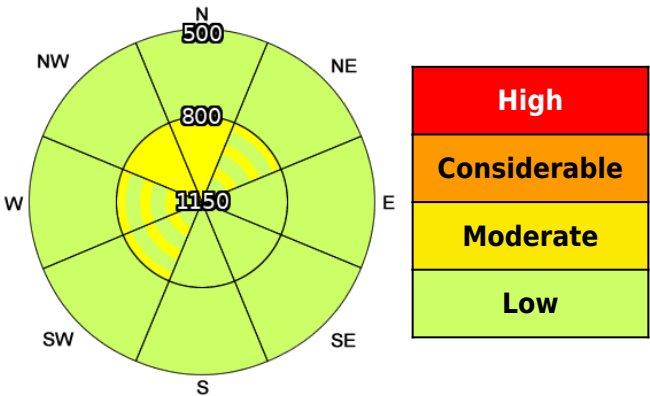
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will be generally well bonded in most areas; however small isolated pockets of windslab will then accumulate in sheltered locations, predominantly on South-West through West to Northerly aspects above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry night with snow showers arriving at around midday. Turning cooler through the day with the freezing level lowering to around 600 metres. Winds will be severe gale force East-South-Easterly throughout the forecast period.

Comments

A very windy couple of days ahead. Stormy outlook but most snow again will be in Eastern ranges.
