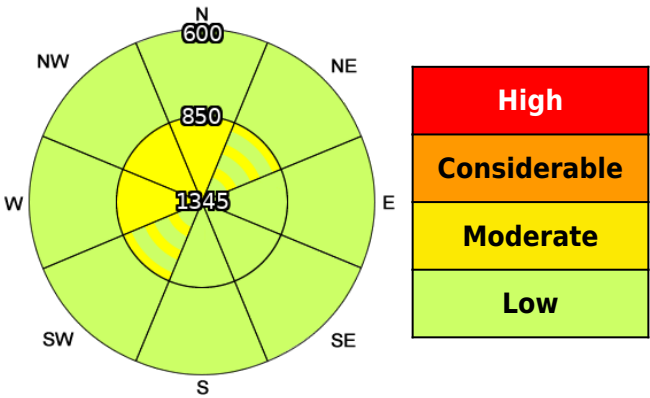
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will be deposited in wind sheltered areas, mainly on West to North aspects above 850 metres. South-West and North-East aspects will also be affected. Accumulations gaining depth are not expected to be extensive. Good stability on ridges and recently wind scoured aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be very strong throughout the forecast period, initially South-Easterly but soon East-South-Easterly. Snow showers above around 800 metres are expected this evening, then dry until the afternoon when there will be light snow showers above 600 metres.
