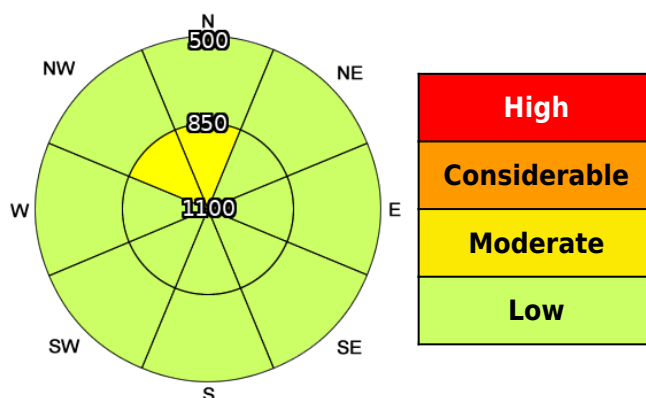

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some widespread wet snow instabilities are expected initially with the onset of any rain. During daylight hours as the snowpack re-freezes stability will improve in all locations. Some new snow instabilities are possible on steep, very sheltered North West to Westerly aspects above 850m later in the day. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Some light precipitation will fall initially as rain to all levels, before turning to snow as the Freezing level lowers during the day to around 600m. The winds will be very strong East South Easterly throughout.
