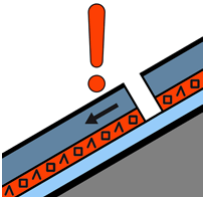

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 20/03/2018

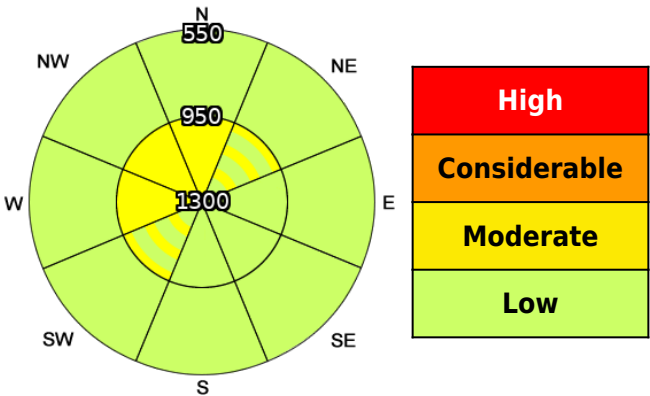
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Stability will continue to improve. Many areas will be wind scoured icy and stable, especially where they have been wind affected and any easterly facing slopes. Some moderately well bonded windslab will persist in localised places predominantly in wind sheltered steep terrain mostly above 950 metres on Westerly to Northerly aspects; convex pillows, gully exits and coire rims especially. Below this level stability is generally good. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry day is expected. Freezing level will be around 500- 600 metres. Winds will be moderate strength Northerly backing North-Westerly by day break.
