

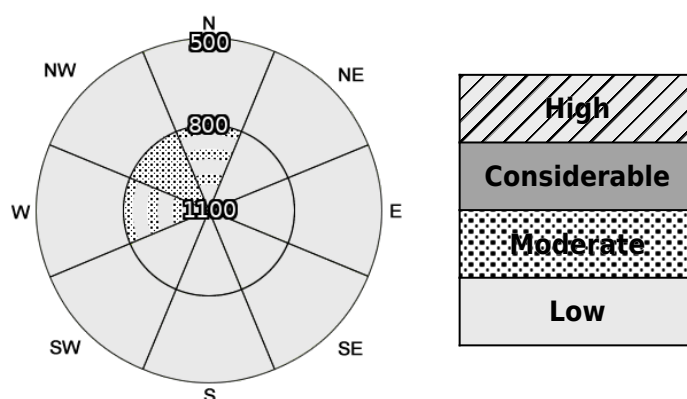

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 20/03/2018

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change. Some localised instability will persist in highest mainly North-Westerly aspects, where recent accumulations of windslab are moderately well bonded. There will be some softening of the snowpack below 700m and localised surface instability is likely on sun affected aspects as surface layers become moist during the day. In other areas it will remain well consolidated, hard, re-frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

High pressure will continue to affect the area. Winds will be light variable, mainly Northerly then West-North-West. Freezing Level 400m overnight rising to around 700m by the end of the day
