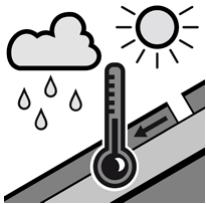


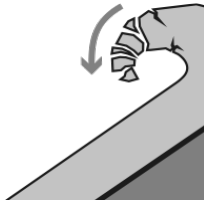

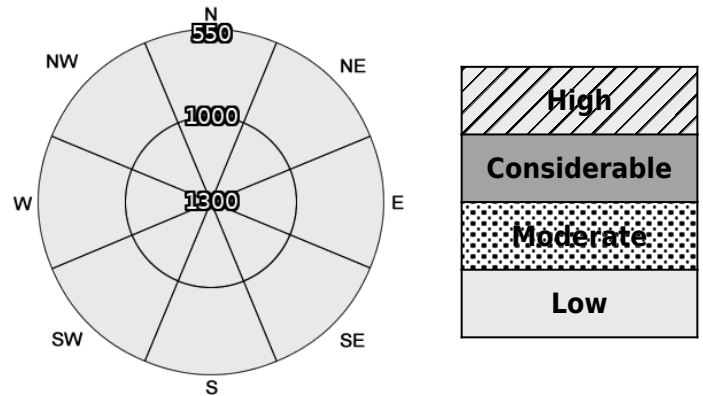

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate in the milder conditions and will be generally stable in all areas. Some surface instabilities may occur on the steepest slopes and cornices that overhang many West to Northerly aspects will be prone to collapse. At lower elevations although soft the snowpack will be stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

A milder day in prospect, freezing levels in the Glens overnight will rise to well above the summits through the day. Some precipitation in the morning falling as showers of sleet or snow, but thereafter it is expected to be dry. Winds increasing in strength light West-South-Westerly overnight becoming very strong Westerly by midday.
